
#### RED VELVET BY LOLITA CHAKRABARTI

THEATRE ROYAL, COVENT GARDEN, 1833. EDMUND KEAN, THE GREATEST ACTOR OF HIS GENERATION, HAS COLLAPSED ON STAGE WHILST PLAYING OTHELLO. A YOUNG BLACK AMERICAN ACTOR HAS BEEN ASKED TO TAKE OVER THE ROLE. ## Historical Background:

- Racism in the 1800's:
- -Slavery Abolished in 1865 in USA
- -Slavery Abolished in 1833 in Britian
- -Racial tensions still extremely high
- -Black actors in 1800's did not recieve the same treatment as other actors i.e. minstrel shows, maid and slave characters in plays, and severe mistreatment in workplace.



## Ira Aldridge's Life

#### Early Life:


Ira Aldridge was born in New York City in 1807. He was born into a family of free African Americans and received his education at the African Free School in New York City. Aldridge, seeking further education that he was not allowed due to racism in the US, moved to England. In England he studied acting at the Royalty Theatre in London.



## Ira Aldridge's Life

Career:

Ira Aldridge while still in New York City, worked as an actor at the African Grove Theatre. The African Grove Theatre was one of the first theaters managed for and by African Americans. He then went on to make his London East End Royalty Theatre Debut as Othello in 1825 marking his first performance in England. He went on to tour Europe as an actor, particularly interested in Shakespearean roles. Aldridge also became an advocate against racism and slavery in his later life with his found
